REPORT OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE

Dear Members.

On behalf of the Managing committee I have pleasure in presenting the Thirtieth Annual Report and the Audited Statements for the year ending 31st March, 2019 along with the Audit Report.

A Glimpse of our Financial Results:

Our endeavor to provide the best facilities and standards to meet our member's aspirations do come at a cost and the path forward will have to be walked with good fiscal prudence. It is necessary to recognize that our club has limited revenues for generating operational income due to space limitations, unlike some of the other leading clubs in the State. At the same time cost of manpower, electricity and other inputs will continue to grow.

Clubs in general work on a cross subsidization model, where activity income gaps are offset by income from rooms, lawns, banqueting and other such facilities in addition to subscription and interest on investments. In our case, we follow a similar model by optimizing room, catering, banqueting income to augment the income from subscription, interest etc. allowing us to offset the deficits in activities.

For the year 2018-19, we are reporting a cash surplus of Rs.36.47 lacs compared to Rs.10.41lacs for the previous year. Total income has increased by Rs.83.42 lacs over last year while operating expense increased by Rs.63.39 lacs. Food Sale and Income from Residential rooms contributed to increase in Income while Repairs and Maintenance, Manpower, Electricity and Activity expenses are the main expenses drivers. During the year Rooms collections has increased from Rs.98.94 lacs to Rs.122.21 lacs, registering a growth of 23% over previous year while food sale increased from Rs.257.22 lacs to Rs.354.20 lacs registering a growth of 38% over previous year.

Our renovated facilities have increased footfall and will need to continue and improve onbalancing the income and expense drivers to offer best services at realistic rates.

Capital fund has increased by Rs.148.42 lacs on account of capitalisation of entrance fee from new members to the tune of Rs.206.60 lacs and set off of depreciation loss of Rs.58.33 lacs.

Additions of Rs.92.06 lacs were made to fixed assets during the year. Of this,

Investments in Fixed Deposits and Bonds have gone up from Rs.351.05 lacs to 525.94 lacs over the year. Surplus funds were invested in Fixed Deposits with the banks and Fixed Deposits were rescheduled from time to time to avail higher interest.

Inventories are up by Rs.50.57 lacs due to procurement of additional bar stock to avail additional discounts.

Loans, Advances, Receivables and other current assets have decreased by Rs.36.78 lacs due converting balances in banks to fixed deposits and investment in Bonds. Dues from members decreased from Rs 64.61 lacs to Rs 57.78 lacs reflecting prompt recovery by the management.

Current Liabilities decreased by Rs.13.81 lacs, mainly on account of repayment of dues to creditors

NOTES ACCOUNTS

SCHEDULE -19: SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES ON ACCOUNTS

STATEMENT ON SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

01. System of Accounting:

The Financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in India. The club follows the accrual method of accounting.

02. Fixed Assets:

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition including freight, excise, local taxes, cost of erection and incidental expenses wherever applicable.

03. Depreciation:

Depreciation on fixed assets is provided on Written down value method at the rates and in the manner prescribed under Section 32 of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

04. Inventories:

The stock of provisions, soft drinks, liquor and other general items are valued at cost.

05. Revenue Recognition:

The Club generally follows mercantile system of accounting and recognizes significant items of income and expenditure on accrual basis. Income & Expenditure from Food & Beverages, Sports & Facilities are shown at net amounts. Revenue from sale of food & beverages is recognized on completion of sale of food & beverages. Income from Games, Sports & Facilities and functions is recognized on receipt basis and all other income is accounted for on accrual basis.

06 Retirement/Employee Benefits:

a) The Provisions of Provident Fund is applicable to the club and the club is generally regular in depositing the dues with appropriate authorities.

- b) Provisions of payment of Gratuity Act apply to the club. Even though there are employees who have put in qualifying service to be eligible for gratuity, provision against liability was not made in the accounts. However, the club is incurring the gratuity expenditure as and when the liability arises by debiting the total payment to expenditure account. Club is also providing leave encashment benefit to the employees.
- c) Provisions of payment of Bonus Act are applicable to the Club. As per the Bonus Act, 8.33% has to be provided in the accounts.

NOTES FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS:

- a) The Club has collected Membership fees of Rs.2,06,60,000/- Thus the total capital infused during the financial year 2018-19 is Rs. 2,06,60,000/-.
- b) The balance outstanding in the CC limits a/c from SBI, Labbipet branch, Vijayawada is Rs. 2,64,637/- as on 31.03.2019. (The sanctioned limit was Rs.16,00,000/-).
- c) Balance of sundry debtors/creditors including dues from members, current assets, Loans and advances have been taken at values as stated in the books of account and have not been confirmed by parties.
- d) Additions to Fixed assets viz., capital expenditure incurred during the financial year is Rs. 92,06,530/- and deletions from Fixed assets is Nil.
- e) Income and expenditure on functions was shown net during the year.
- f) The total Fixed Deposits in Balance sheet as at 31.03.2019 is Rs. 4,75,93,769 /- (Including accrued interest thereon)
- g) Sales and purchase figures are shown at net of GST.
- h) Bank Reconciliation statements have been prepared by the management.

- The figures shown under inventories are certified by the management. Valuation of closing stock and physical stock taking is done by the management.
- j) Administrative expenses include auditors remuneration of Rs.20,000/
 towards Statutory Audit Fee and Rs.3,600/- towards GST.
- k) There are no claims against the club contingent in nature.
- The figures of the previous year have been regrouped/reclassified/ rearranged wherever necessary so as to confirm with current year's classification.
